Dear Mr. Taylor:

I am writing this letter further to my correspondence of November 6, 1997 at which time I advised you your recurrence was denied in relation to our meeting of November 12, 1997, at the Workers' Compensation head office.

On November 12, 1997 we met and discussed your claim at which time I informed you I would refer this claim to the Board doctor for review.

This claim was referred to a Board doctor for a further review with the medical evidence on file. A physician's re-open report dated September 26, 1997 gives no objective findings of any impairment. There is also no evidence that your current problems are related to the initial injury in this claim. Therefore, this letter is to inform you that the decision to deny your recurrence of August 19, 1997 is upheld.

If you do not understand the reasons for the decision, or if you do not agree with the conclusions reached, please call me. I would be pleased to discuss your concerns.
