## SECOND CASE MANAGEMENT ENDORSEMENT

- 1. This endorsement reflects a case management conference conducted by teleconference on January 19, 2021. This is the second case management conference conducted in this matter.
- 2. The previous case management endorsement set a schedule for a motion being brought by Mr. Taylor pursuant to section 21(5) of the *Court of Justice Act* to review an order made by Sachs J. on October 10, 2020 dismissing his application for judicial review.
- 3. Mr. Taylor recently contacted the Divisional Court to advise that he was not able to meet the deadline for the service of his materials set out in the previous case management endorsement. The schedule is amended as follows:
  - a. Mr. Taylor is to serve his motion record and factum on the respondent by Friday, February 5, 2021; and
  - b. The Tribunal is to serve its responding record, if any, and factum on Mr. Taylor by February 26, 2021.
- 4. Materials are to be uploaded to Caselines by no later than February 26, 2021 in accordance with the instructions set out in the November 23, 2020 Case Management Endorsement.
- 5. The hearing will proceed, as previously scheduled, on March 8, 2021.

- 6. During the case conference, Mr. Taylor also indicated that he wants to obtain a transcript of the hearing before Sachs J.. Mr. Taylor is directed to contact the court at <u>Toronto.SCJ.CourtReporters@ontario.ca</u> to make the request. If he wants the transcript in advance of the March 8, 2021 hearing date, he should make the request immediately. However, as discussed during the case conference, the hearing will not be adjourned for the purpose of obtaining the transcript unless Mr. Taylor can demonstrate that he requires the transcript for his motion. Given that there was no testimony given by witnesses at the motion before Sachs J., it would be very unusual for the transcript of that hearing to be needed for the March 8, 2021 review hearing.
- 7. If the parties believe there are points from the case management conference that are not reflected in this endorsement, they should notify the court by email as soon as they can.
